

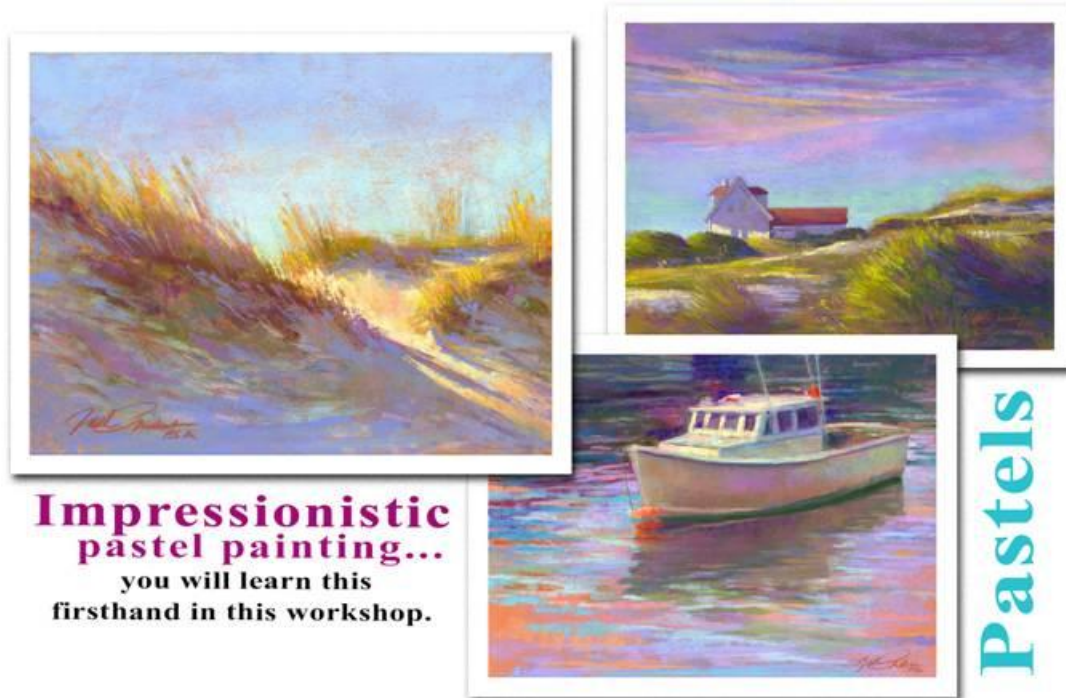

Jack is a hands-on instructor who will be available to assist you at your easel several times each day. He will perform several demonstrations during the workshop. You may ask any questions you like during the demos. Each day will end with a review and constructive critique of your work. The workshop will begin with a Thursday night wine and cheese get-together. Jack will display many of his paintings and discuss the goals and procedures for the workshop. Please bring in some of your recent pastel work for critique. Class days are busy and information packed, but Jack teaches in a light-hearted manner with a big emphasis on fun. Come with an open mind, a sturdy easel, and be prepared to work outdoors at

many beautiful locations and in the studio for half a day. In the event of inclement weather, the class will continue inside the Studio. *Jack will inspire you to new painting horizons in your pastel painting!*
